The vulnerable and the dying, whether young or old often need palliative or end of life care. These must include medical, spiritual, psychological and human assistance. These do not imply a focus on healing people who are beyond healing but, at the same time, their care should not be diminished as they journey towards their death. "Not being cured" should not be replaced with "not being cared for". The most vulnerable who may not be able to speak or express their needs require our particular attention as they cry out: "Do not cast me off in the time of old age; forsake me not when my strength is spent." (Psalm 71:9). They must be accompanied in their suffering and in their dying, rather than their death be provoked or facilitated. (Quote from Bishops' Conference)
